For Players of the Year, look no further than the three in this set: Glenn "Big Dog" Robinson from 1994 Purdue with 30.3 PPG and 10.1 RPG, Kevin Durant from 2007 Texas with 25.8 PPG and 11.1 RPG, and Zion Williamson from 2019 Duke with 22.6 PPG. This set is not without its current pro basketball stars, either. We have James Harden (2009 Arizona State), and Damian Lillard (2012 Weber State).

Other stars, past and present, include Hal Perry & K.C.
