Cailin Clark had a strong senior season in her final run at Iowa. She averaged 36.3 PPG, 8.4 REB, and 10.2 AST, all while shooting 37.8% from three-point territory. This was also Lisa Bluder's final season as coach for Iowa. Bluder went 1075-716 in her career at both Drake and Iowa. While Iowa won the Big 10 Tournament scoring 95, 95, and 94 points in the three games, they lost the national final to an undefeated South Carolina team.

BANK SHOT BASKETBALL WOMEN'S COLLEGE BASKETBALL TIMING RULES

Since the 2015-2016 season, women's college basketball games are played using four 10-minute quarters, with a 15-minute halftime. For Bank Shot Basketball game purposes, you will divide the Action deck into seven roughly equal stacks. Select one of the stacks to represent half of a quarter (5 minutes) and add or subtract cards equal to the PACE ratings of each team. Take cards from one of the other stacks to increase the cards in the selected stack.

Each team has 4 time outs available. No more than 3 time outs carry over to the second half. Each team is given 1 time out each over time period. Any time outs not used in regulation carry over to over time.

BANK SHOT BASKETBALL WOMEN'S COLLEGE BASKETBALL FOUL RULES

Team fouls reset to zero at the end of each quarter. After the fourth team foul in each quarter, the opponent reaches the bonus and shoots two free throws beginning with the fifth foul and each subsequent foul.

All other BANK SHOT BASKETBALL game rules remain the same.
