The national champions in this set 1946 Oklahoma A&M (later Oklahoma State), 1973 UCLA, and 2017 North Carolina. It's a nice showcase for legendary coaches Hank Iba, John Wooden, and Roy Williams. The NCAA Players of the Year include Bill Walton (1973 UCLA) and Joe Smith (1995 Maryland). Players who were the #1 pick in that season's NBA Draft include Bill Bradley (1965 Princeton), Bob Lanier (1970 St. Bonaventure), Joe Smith (1995 Maryland), Allen Iverson (1996 Georgetown), Ben Simmons (2016 LSU), and Markelle Fultz (2017 Washington). For your set's doormat, look no further than 1996 Chicago State, a 2-25 team coached by NBA veteran Craig Hodges. Look also for 1999 SIU-Edwardsville, a team that can maintain their own against other small schools in other sets but who will struggle against D1 schools.

For fans of Boston, we also have in this set Tiny Archibald (1970 UTEP), Robert Parish (1976 Centenary LA), and Kevin McHale (1980 Minnesota).
