

Bank Shot Basketball is back with **COLLEGE SET 13**. Set 013 is the 2025 Sweet Sixteen set that includes the Sweet 16 from the 2025 Tournament, 11 regular season conference champions, and the five first-team All-American selections. It also includes the Player of the Year in Cooper Flagg (Duke) and the nation's leading scorer, Eric Dixon (Villanova). We also have new homes for John Calipari at Arkansas, Mark Pope at Kentucky, and Rick Pitino at St. John's. Bradley had the highest three-point percentage for any team in the nation in 2025 and UC-San Diego had the second-highest margin of victory (Duke had the largest MOV). UC Irvine made the finals of the NIT Tournament.

The 2025 Sweet 16 included: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Auburn, BYU, Duke, Florida, Houston, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, Mississippi, Purdue, Tennessee, and Texas Tech.

Other marquee players in the set (not already named above) include Mark Sears (Alabama), Caleb Love & Carter Bryant (Arizona), Johni Broome (Auburn), Richie Saunders & Egor Demin (BYU), Ryan Kalkbrenner (Creighton), Bennett Stirtz (Drake), Kon Knueppel & Tyrese Proctor & Khaman Maluach (Duke), Walter Clayton (Florida), LJ Cryer (Houston), Kasparas Jakucionis & Will Riley (Illinois), Curtis Jones (Iowa State), Derik Queen (Maryland), Danny Wolf (Michigan), Jase Richardson (Michigan State), Trey Kaufman-Renn & Braden Smith (Purdue), Dylan Harper & Ace Bailey (Rutgers), RJ Luis (St. John's), Augustas Marciulionas (Saint Mary's), Chaz Lanier (Tennessee), and JT Toppin (Texas Tech).

The doormat of this set is Mississippi Valley State, who had the lowest SRS in the nation.
