However, this set also has a bit of a baseball theme as we include HOF pitcher Bob Gibson averaging 22 PPG and 7.6 REB for 1956 Creighton, Dave Winfield for 1973 Minnesota, Tim Lincecum playing for 1975 NC State, and Tony Gwynn playing for 1980 San Diego State,

The national champions are 1968 UCLA, 1971 UCLA, and 1990 UNLV. Other Final Four teams include 1965 Michigan, 1968 Ohio State, 1969 Drake, 1969 Purdue, 1989 Seton Hall, 1991 Kansas, 1998 Utah, and 2013 Wichita State. A special nod goes to 1972 Eastern Michigan, who was in Division II's final four.
